



Common USB Ports

Name	Picture	Usage
USB A Plug		The most standard of all USB Plugs
USB A Socket (Extension)		The Socket for USB A. Used in Extension leads
USB B Plug		Device end of standard USB Cable Printers, External Hard Drives (3.5")
Mini USB plug		USB B Socket used when devices were too small for a standard socket B Small Devices Small External HDD
Micro USB plug		USB B Socket used when devices were too small for a Mini socket B Phones Drones Battery Packs
USB C plug		New USB Plug to replace all USB plugs

Specialty USB Ports

Name	Picture	Usage
USB A Reversible Plug (non-standard)		A non-standard reversible version of the USB A plug with right-angled cable. The middle is pliable and able to move to plug into a USB A socket either way. Any USB device
USB A Super Speed Plug.		The USB 3 Standard included SuperSpeed Plugs to allow 5Gbit/sec Transfers. External Hard Drives
USB B Super Speed Plug.		The USB 3 Standard included SuperSpeed Plugs to allow 5Gbit/sec Transfers. External Hard Drives
Apple Lightning Plug		Proprietary Apple 8 pin Lightning connector for iPhone 5+ & iPad 3+
Apple Lightning Plug with 90 degree Cable and power LED		Proprietary Apple 8 pin Lightning connector for iPhone 5+ & iPad 3+
